SAN ANTONIO---Many of the 1,158 rodeo contestants have made one appearance at the San Antonio Stock Show and Rodeo as of Monday.

While there are 15 performance left in the regular competition, each event fetures more than one round, so contestants have been here once and are making plans for their return trip.

The steer wrestling, calf roping and team roping all feature two full rounds of competition. In order to accommodate the number of contestants in those events, prerodeo competition or slack was held last Thursday and Friday. The first round in the steer wrestling and calf roping were completed at that time, so all of the contestants in the rodeo are now making their second appearance.

The team roping, saddle bronc riding and the women's barrel racing are also two complete rounds of competition. Some of the team ropers competed in slack in the first round. The first round in the team roping was complete here on Monday. The second round begins at the fifth performance on Tuesday night.

The barrel racers are all scheduled to compete back-to-back. They make their first run in one performance and their second one in the following performance.

The bareback riders get to spend more time in San Antonio than any other contestants. Each of them gets to ride three times before the finals. Their three scores will be added together to determine the final's qualifiers.

Bull riding is one of the most popular events for both fans and contestants. All of the bull riders compete in the first round. The top 48 move into a progressive round and have the opportunity to ride here again.

The top twelve contestants in each of these events will qualify for the finals on Sunday, Feb. 18. At this time the bulk of the prize money will be paid out, the prestigious San Antonio championship belt buckles will be awarded and the all-around champion will receive a brand new GMC truck.

Tuesday's rodeo performance will start at 7 p.m. Country Western performing artist Mark Wills will follow the competition.
