San Antonio Rodeo Comes to a Close

SAN ANTONIO --- The final day of the San Antonio Stock Show Rodeo was filled with highs and lows.

Among the highest of the highs was Steven Turner, from Cochrane, Alberta, Canada. Turner started this week with only \$17 in his pocket. He left the SBC Center with \$10,621 in winnings. Turner, who is attending school in Snyder Texas won the bull riding here. The lows also came in the bull riding when the other 10 ProRodeo Tour Round qualifiers bucked off. Turner had a total score of 228 on three bulls to win the title.

The high money winner was Jade Conner from Iowa, La. Conner roped and tied three calves in 25.1 seconds to win the title and \$13,387. Bryan Fields from Conroe, Texas, was close behind Conner in earnings. Fields brought three steers to the ground in 12.9 to win the championship and \$13,387. Fields also had the fastest time of the rodeo on the U.S. Smokeless Tobacco Co. scoreboard with a 3.5 second run, setting an arena record.

Sherry Cervi took a year off from rodeo competition last year. She's back barrel racing in a big way. This is the first rodeo that she has competed in this year and she ended up winning the title. Cervi from Marana, Ariz., collected \$9,523.

Lan LaJeunesse has two world championships in the bareback riding. He's also knows the highs and lows of rodeo. After winning his second title in 2001, the Morgan, Utah resident missed qualifying for the Wrangler National Finals Rodeo in 2002 by \$23. He experienced another high when he won the bareback riding here and \$10,167.

Jason Stewart from Royal City, Wash., won his second consecutive San Antonio team roping title. He won it last year roping with Randon Adams. He won it this year with Mike Beers from Powell Butte, Ore., doing the heeling. Beers and Stewart each won \$8,011.

Mike Outhier from nearby Utopia won't have to haul his \$9,523 far. Outhier collected his money and the championship in the saddle bronc riding. The all-around championship went to Casey Branquinho from Los Alamos, Calif. Branquinho won over \$7,000 in the calf roping and steer wrestling to win the buckle. He also collected a \$25,000 bonus for the win.

Total pay-off at this year's rodeo passed the \$520,000 mark.
