### Third Stop on Tour Promises to be Exciting

SAN ANTONIO --- The Wrangler ProRodeo Tour Round of the San Antonio Stock Show Rodeo will be action-packed, featuring the best contestants and best livestock.

This rodeo is the third of 10 stops on the Tour. Contestants have already garnered U.S. Smokeless Tobacco Co. points in Denver and Rapid City, S.D. At the end of the Tour, the top 12 in each event will qualify for the Finale which will be held in Las Vegas at the MGM Grand in June.

There are world champion titles represented throughout the contestant roster. Leading the pack in the team roping are current and five-time world champions Speed Williams from Jacksonville, Fla., and Rich Skelton from Llano, Texas. In addition, there are five more world champions that will be featured in the team roping, including seven-time title holders, Jake Barnes from Cave Creek, Ariz., and Clay OBrien Cooper from Glen Rose, Texas. Other title holders include Allen Bach from Weatherford, Texas; Tee Woolman from Llano, Texas; and Dennis Motes from Telephone, Texas.

The 2000 world champion bull rider, Cody Hancock from Taylor, Ariz., took the lead in that event on Saturday night. Hancock moved to the top of the U.S. Smokeless Tobacco Co. scoreboard with a total score of 172 points on two rides. He will be joined in the bull riding by Jesse Bail, who is the front runner for the all-around champion here. Bail is the only contestant to have won money in two events, the bull riding and the saddle bronc riding. Bail has qualified for the Tour round in both of those events and is nearly a shoo-in to be driving the new GMC truck awarded for the all-around championship here.

Ten-time world champion barrel racer Charmayne James will be taking her horse Cruiser around the cloverleaf pattern. James, from Athens, Texas, will be joined by local favorite Kay Blandford from Sutherland Springs, Texas.

Not only will the best contestants compete here, the top livestock will be features. Three-time world champion bucking horse Spring Fling will be doing her best to toss cowboys to the dirt. In the bull riding, world champion bulls, Border Patrol, Yellow Jacket, and Rapid Fire are expected to show their championship abilities.

The final performance of the San Antonio Stock Show Rodeo will be at 4 p.m. on Sunday.
