Sandvick Keeps Winning and Winning and Winning

SAN ANTONIO --- Just one day after winning a silver medal at the Olympic Command Performance Rodeo, Larry Sandvick is at it again.

Sandvick flew from Salt Lake City to San Antonio to compete in the second round of bareback riding. Sandvick tied for third place in the first round and won nearly \$2,000. He won the National Western Stock Show Rodeo in Denver in January. He knew he had a good opportunity here on Wednesday.

The horse that Sandvick had the opportunity to ride was Bear Sign, owned by Bruce Sundstrom. When the judges totaled up the numbers, Sandvick received an 80 point score. Combined with his first round score of 81, Sandvick now leads the over-all standings with a total of 161 points on two rides. Sandvick is nearly assured a top position in Sundays finals.

There is a new leader on the U.S. Smokeless Tobacco Co. scoreboard in the second round of team roping. Header Travis Tryan from Billings, Mont., and heeler Cody Cowden from Merced, Calif., stopped the clock in 4.8 seconds. They also moved into fourth place in the over-all standings and are looking for a Wrangler ProRodeo Tour Round qualification on Sunday.

The first round of bull riding is over and one of the big winners has come out of the ranks of the National Intercollegiate Rodeo Association. Jarrod Ford from Kersey, Colo., qualified for the College National Finals Rodeo last year and is now making a name for himself in the Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association. Ford, along with Logan Knibbe from Rockdale, Texas, each scored 87 points to win \$3,732.

There 15th performance of the San Antonio Stock Show Rodeo will be Wednesday at 7 p.m.
