ENTRIES – JUNIOR SHOW ENTRIES ACCEPTED ONLINE ONLY- NO EXCEPTIONS!

- * All Junior Exhibitors must complete and sign Jr. Entry Form – available on the website.
- * Judging Contests and Ag. Mechanics Forms must be completed.
- * CEA/AST will complete online entry process.
- * CEA/AST will mail Jr. Entry Forms, Judging Contest entry forms, Ag Mechanics entry forms, and Club/Chapter Summary (printed from internet), and payment postmarked by Dec. 1, 2007.
- * Login- should be four digits. (4-H= 4 plus County Unit Number; FFA=National Chapter ID Number)
- * Password- there is no password for the first login. One can be created after the first login.


MARKET STEERS

- * Arrive: Tuesday, Feb. 12, 1 am- 8 am.
- * Exhibitors must check-in and complete Validation Number, Weight and Breed Designation on the Disposition Form. Check-in must be completed by Tuesday, Feb. 12 at Noon, or be disqualified
- * Auction will be held Saturday, Feb. 16, 9 am

MARKET GOATS

- * Arrive Thursday, Feb. 7, 6 am-Noon.
-  Market Goat exhibitors will now be required to turn in weights.
- * Exhibitors must check-in their market goat by documenting its Texas Validation Number and Weight on the Disposition Form provided by the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo. Check-in must be completed by Thursday, Feb. 7 at 3 pm, or be disqualified.
- * Only State Validation tags are allowed
- * Photos will be taken on 3rd-10th place goats
- * Auction will be held Saturday, Feb. 16, 3:30 pm

MARKET LAMBS

- * Arrive Monday, Feb. 11, 6 am-Noon.
-  Market Lamb exhibitors will now be required to turn in weights.
- * Exhibitors must check-in their market lamb by documenting its Texas Validation Number, Weight, and Breed Designation on the Disposition Form provided by the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo. Check-in must be completed by Monday, Feb. 11 at 3 pm, or be disqualified.
- * Only State Validation tags and Texas Lamb Breeders tags are allowed
- * Auction will be held Thursday, Feb. 14, 5:30 pm

MARKET BARROWS

- * Arrive: (Group 1) Saturday, Feb. 9, 1am-7am
(Group 2) Tuesday, Feb. 12, 5am-Noon
- * Exhibitors must check-in their market barrow by documenting its Texas Validation Number, Weight, and Breed Designation on the Disposition Form provided by the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo. The form must be turned in by 2 pm on the arrival date of either group
- * Only State Validation tags are allowed
- * Auction will be held Friday, Feb. 15, 4 pm

AGRICULTURE SCIENCE FAIR

- * Arrive and Show: Saturday, Feb. 2
- * Entries limited to individuals only – NO teams allowed

TACK TRUCKS

- * Please combine all tack into one truck. Bring only what you need. All tack trucks must stage at Gemblor Road and stay in line with their group.
- * S.A.LE. will have the final determination of what a tack truck is.

- * Only students entered in the contest may participate.

BREEDING SHEEP & GOATS

- * Arrive: Boer Goats, Saturday, Feb. 2-; Show and Release on Sunday, Feb. 3
Angora Goats, Sunday, Feb. 3; Show and Release on Monday, Feb. 4
Breeding Sheep, Monday, Feb. 4
- * Open Sheep Show, Tuesday, Feb. 5
- * Junior Sheep Show and Release, Wednesday, Feb. 6

AG MECHANICS

- * Substitution of students will be allowed only until Dec. 15, 2007. After this date, the only modification that can be made is the removal of students from a project entry.
- * Substitution of projects before January. 15 is free. After this time, there will be an additional entry fee for the project.

CALF SCRAMBLE

- * 19 scramble performances, due to new rodeo schedule.
- * Minor's Release Forms will be sent via email to District or Area Coordinators. Due Oct. 1, 2007.
- * Last day for scramblers (not alternates) to apply to change performance date is Jan.15, 2008.
- * Medical survey forms will be required for each contestant. Forms will be mailed to the contestant's Supervisor and must be completed and mailed to Livestock Office by Jan. 15, 2008.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- * No butt fans, whether overhead or on stands are allowed.
- * The 2008 Premium List will be available ONLINE ONLY at www.sarodeo.com under the Livestock Show tab.
- * No cooking will be allowed (No - coffee pots, warmers, microwaves, crock pots, etc.)
- * Limited unloading assistance will be provided.
- * Breeding Registration papers- make sure they meet the appropriate guidelines before you leave home! Papers are subject to verification at any time. Registration papers must state the name of one Junior owner. (No ranch names or partnerships)
- * Don't forget the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (health paper) - required by the Texas Animal Health Commission for ALL breeding animals.
- * Tie outs may be purchased at the time of arrival only. Tie outs will not be sold in advance. Tie out money sent with entries will not be refunded.
