SPECIAL RULES

In the event of bulk milk sales, samples will be taken and tested for antibiotic residues. If residues are found, milk payments will not be made. Contributing exhibitor will be disqualified.

In the event of bulk milk sales all proceeds will be disbursed in accordance with guidelines set by the Texas Purebred Dairy Cattle Association. The San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo reserves the right to keep, sell, or not sell any or all of the milk collected during the Dairy Cattle Show.

1. Entry: Fill out one Open Entry Form per owner. Open Show Entry must be made on an Open Show Entry Form. The San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo reserves the right to use any Dairy Cattle for the Dairy Judging Contest.

2. Ownership/Registration: Animals must be registered in the Herdbook of their Association in the name of the owner(s) not less than thirty days prior to the opening day of the General Livestock Show. Purchase, delivery, possession and registration must all take place not less than thirty days prior to the opening day of the General Livestock Show. Superintendents will check Original Registration Certificates at time of check-in. If animals in a herd are registered in different names but the herd is operated as a single unit, entries will be considered as one owner for group and premier classes.

3. Milking: A milk out may be requested by an owner if the request is made prior to judging and filed according to official protest procedures. The judge will make the final decision.

4. Premium Schedule (standard classes):

Premium	\$45	\$35	\$30

5. Stalling: Dairy animals will be stalled in Cattle Barn #2. The number of stalls assigned will be determined by the number of head actually present. Double-entered animals will be assigned one stall only. Stalling will occur on a first-come, first-serve basis; animals must arrive together to be stalled together.

6. Group Classes: Group classes must be entered at time of check-in by filling out an entry form with Superintendent; there will be no entry fee or premiums paid.

Junior-Best-Three Females (Holstein): Three (3) animals eligible for Jr. Champion bred by exhibitor and at least two (2) owned by exhibitor.

Best-Three-Females (Brown Swiss): Three (3) head, any age, all bred and at least one (1) owned by exhibitor. One (1) entry per owner

Junior Get-of-Sire (Brown Swiss): Four (4) head, three (3) bred and one (1) owned by exhibitor. One (1) entry per bull.

Produce of Dam: Two (2) animals, any age, the produce of one (1) cow. Animals need not be owned by the exhibitor.

Breeder's Herd: Two (2) females shown in classes eligible for Junior Champion, two (2) females shown in classes eligible for Senior Champion, and one (1) female any age, all owned and at least three (3) bred by owner. Limit-one entry per owner.

Premier Exhibitor: The exhibitor accumulating the most points on not more than six (6) animals owned and shown in single classes.

Premier Breeder: The exhibitor accumulating the most points on not more than six (6) animals shown in single classes. The point system is:
