SPECIAL RULES

This show is subject to the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo General Rules, the Junior Livestock Show Special Rules, and Special Rules listed in this section.

1. **Entry Fees:** Breed Associations may require additional entry fees. Please read association guidelines.
2. **Entry:** Each owner may enter two (2) heifers.

3. Double Entry: Heifers may be double entered in the Open Show if they are eligible under Department JH. To double enter into the Open Show, the following must be completely filled out and submitted:

1 Junior Entry form & 1 Open Entry form

All owner and animal information must be identical. Separate entry fees must be made for both the Open and Junior Shows. Double Entry in Open Show does not entitle Junior Show animal's additional stalls and passes.

4. Ownership/Registration: Animals must be registered in the Herdbook of their Association in the name of the Junior owner on or before November 1, the year preceding the Show. Purchase, delivery, possession, transfer, and registration must all take place on or before November 1st, the year preceding the Show. Superintendents will check Original Registration Certificates at time of check-in. Registration Certificates must be available at all times.

5. Judging: Overall Supreme Champion & Reserve Supreme Champion Heifer will be judged at the conclusion of the Show. All Breed Champions and Reserve Breed Champions must participate in the Supreme Champion Heifer Drive or be subject to disqualification.

6. Grooming Materials: No grooming material is allowed. This is a "Blow and Go" Show.

7. Special Rules: Owners must comply with the special rules of the respective breed associations.

8. Fans: Fans will not be permitted in aisles. No fans behind cattle.

9. Generators: No generators will be allowed on grounds.

10. Trim Chutes: No Trim Chutes are permitted on the grounds during the Jr. Heifer Show.

11. Clippers: No clippers, which require an electrical current, are allowed on Jr. Heifers once they arrive on the grounds. Cordless clippers are allowed.

12. Stalling: Junior Breeding Beef Heifers will be stalled upon arrival. No stalls will be used for tack or lounging. FFA Chapters and/or 4-H Clubs wishing to be stalled together must wait until all members of the group, which they want to stall with, arrive on the Gemblor Rd lot, to be stalled together.

SPECIAL RULES

1. To be eligible for Association premiums, heifer entries must be recorded in the sole name of the Junior exhibitor and the issue date of transfer of ownership must conform to the individual show's requirements. Association premiums will be mailed directly to the exhibitor from the American Angus Association. The Association's contribution is included in the total premiums listed in each class.
2. Premiums for the Association are paid by registration number. Therefore, all cattle should be registered at the time of entry to make certain they receive the Association's portion of premiums. The Association does not pay a percentage on premiums offered in championship classes.
3. Exhibitors must have the original registration certificate on each animal available for inspection at the show. Any animal on check-in, which does not have a legible tattoo corresponding to its registration certificate, is ineligible to show. Once disqualified due to an incorrect or illegible tattoo, animals cannot be re-tattooed and rechecked at the show.
4. Any female shown with a calf at side, the calf must be her natural calf and be registered.
5. Only one person at a time shall lead animals into the show ring.
6. Any product administered internally or used externally to alter the conformation and/or appearance of an animal for exhibition is prohibited. This includes the covering of white skin, false tail heads (or use of any false hair), use of graphite, powders, hemp or other similar substance externally and steroids, growth stimulants or artificial filling internally. Any animal found to be in violation will be barred from showing. The exhibition of cattle displaying false hair will not be allowed.
7. For an exhibitor to be eligible at shows for premium moneys contributed by the American Angus Association, each exhibitor is subject to series of the Association's rules.
8. Blood Typing for Parentage Verification: Under the Association Rules, each animal for which entry application (registration) is received, may be subjected to a blood type test to verify both ACCURACY OF PARENTAGE AND BLOOD TYPE.

1. Animals must be registered with the United Braford Breeders Association and exhibitors must be Junior Members of the UBB.
2. All entries must have legible identification (tattoo or brand) and same must conform to the identification recorded on the registration certificate. The original registration certificate must be available for inspection during check-in at the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo.
3. Cattle must be classified as Braford to be eligible to show. No F-1, multiple generation half blood, 3/4 Hereford, 3/4 Brahman, Single Bar or other percentage cattle will be accepted. Call the UBB office at (936) 569-8200 if you have registration certificates indicating classification in the old system and need eligibility clarification.
4. The association and its representatives have the authority to require such tests as they deem necessary to verify the accuracy of the classification and pedigree of exhibited animals. Said authority shall extend to and cover the enforcement of all registration and show rules as adopted by the United Braford Breeders.
5. Each exhibitor shall submit his registered Braford cattle to such tests and examinations as requested and/or required by the UBB, its authorized representatives, or the authorized representatives of the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo. These tests include but are not limited to a dental examination for the purpose of age verification. If an official veterinarian determines that, in his opinion, dental development exceeds maximum allowable limits, the animal can be removed from the show.
6. For and in consideration of the opportunity to participate in any Braford function, each exhibitor hereby releases UBB, its officers, directors and representatives from negligence, any and all claims, suits and judgments past, present or future, arising from or connected with the administration or use of such test or examination and the resulting decisions there from.
