(Must be out by 8 pm, Thursday, February 7)TBA **Supreme Champion Gilt Drive** SB**SPECIAL RULES****This show is subject to the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo General Rules, the Junior Livestock Show Special Rules, and Special Rules listed in this section.**

- 1. Eligibility:** The Junior Breeding Swine Show is open to gilts only.
- 2. Entry:** Each owner must fill out one Junior Entry Form listing breed and number of head. Junior Show Entry must be made on a Junior Show Entry Form and Junior Summary Form. Gilts may be double-entered in the Open Show. Open Show Entry Form must be filled out along with an additional Open Show fee of \$20 per head.
- 3. Number Shown:** Each owner may enter a maximum of four head in the Junior Breeding Swine Show.
- 4. Ownership/Registration:** Animals must be registered in the Herdbook of their Association in the name of the Junior owner on or before December 1st, the year preceding the Show. Purchase, delivery, possession, transfer and registration must all take place on or before December 1st, the year preceding the Show. Superintendents will check Original Registration Certificates at time of check-in. Registration Certificates must be available at all times.
- 5. Fitting:** The use of talc, oils or any foreign material will not be permitted. No clipping of swine will be permitted on grounds. No electric clippers will be allowed on grounds. Failure to comply with this rule will result in disqualification.

6. Judging: Overall Supreme Champion & Reserve Supreme Champion Gilt will be judged at the conclusion of the Show. All Breed Champions and Reserve Breed Champions must participate in the Supreme Champion Gilt Drive or be subject to disqualification.

7. Premiums: The following premium schedule will apply to all breeds.

8. Age: All gilts must have been farrowed between **July 1 and September 10, 2007 inclusive**.

9. Classes: Classes within each breed will be broken by age following check-in. There will be 42 classes of gilts (excluding champion classes). The number of classes per breed will be determined following check-in and based upon the percentage of that breed to the total number of gilts in the show.
