

# QUARTER HORSE SHOW

February 5, 8, & 9, 2008

American Quarter Horse Association and Texas Quarter Horse Association

This show will be conducted in full accordance with the American Quarter Horse Association's Official Handbook of Rules and Regulations. \* All around honors must meet AQHA category criteria to qualify (AQHA Rule 417).

**GENERAL RULES:** Read the General Rules in the front of the premium list for health requirements, arrival/departure times, stalls, passes, etc.

**SCHOLARSHIPS:** A \$10,000, \$6,000 and \$4,000 scholarship will be awarded in the Senior (14-18) Youth Division. Points for the scholarships will be computed on a "*one horse, one rider basis*". Speed Classes count toward scholarship. See General Rules for Scholarship Eligibility and Requirements.

**ENTRIES:** Enter online at [www.sarodeo.com](http://www.sarodeo.com). Entry forms, horse's registration papers and copy of AQHA cards must be postmarked by January 10<sup>th</sup>.

**ENTRY DEADLINES:** Entries must be postmarked by January 10<sup>th</sup>. Entries after this date will be accepted online only. The last date to enter online **without a late fee** is January 20<sup>th</sup>. The last date to enter online is January 31<sup>st</sup> and a \$20 late fee per horse will apply. Entries at the show will incur a \$50 late fee.

**CLASS FEES:** Exhibitors can choose between entering unlimited classes for a **\$100 flat rate fee** (includes class fees and AQHA Drug Fee but excludes cattle class fees) or **pay for individual classes**. Class schedule indicates the total fee for all shows if paid by the entry deadline. Class fees for cutting, working cow horse and roping include cattle charges.

**STALLS:** A stall is mandatory for every horse entering the grounds. Horse stalls are \$50 and tack stalls are \$75. **All stalls must be purchased in advance with entries.**

**AQHA DRUG FEE:** A \$6 (\$3 per judge) AQHA Drug Fee will be charged for each horse entered in the show.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Anyone exhibiting in an AQHA Approved Show must be a current individual member of the American Quarter Horse Association. Any horse entered must be listed under its complete registered Name and Number, or its Appendix, or New Appendix, following its name. All horses will be shown in accordance with AQHA Rules. Horses must be entered and shown under the Name of Owner as currently recorded with the AQHA at time of entry. The age of a horse shall be computed by calendar year starting with January 1<sup>st</sup> of year foaled. Junior horses are five years of age and younger. Senior horses are six years of age and older.

Performance Halter exhibitors must provide proof of ROM in the form of either (1) Letter from AQHA or (2) ROM Certificate from AQHA or (3) Printed eligibility from the horse's record and awards on the AQHA website. This verification must accompany entry form in order to be eligible to participate in a Performance Halter Class. A horse may show in only one halter class in a particular division.

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:** All entries must be made on Quarter Horse Show entry forms with only one owner and one horse per form or submitted online at www.sarodeo.com. A photocopy of Registration Certificate, front and back, showing current owner, and if old type certificate is used (Owner listed on back) must accompany mail-in entry but must see original certificate at show. A copy of current applicable AQHA Membership Cards - Open, Amateur, Novice Amateur, Youth, Novice Youth - must be enclosed with entry forms and payment. Entry is not complete without payment. Do not send fee for AQHA and AQHYA dues.

**DOUBLE JUDGED/DOUBLE POINTS:** Double judged/double points is defined as the use of two judges judging independently of each other at one show; therefore, requiring two sets of judges class cards. Each of the judge's placing will result in separate results; therefore, two full sets of AQHA points will be awarded.

**AWARDS:** An award will be awarded to Highpoint and Reserve Highpoint in the following Performance Divisions: Open Horse, Amateur, Novice Amateur, Youth 13 & Under, Youth 14-18, and Novice Youth. A trophy buckle will be awarded to Highpoint in the Select Amateur Division. The points from the Select Amateur Division will count only for the Select Amateur Award and not the Amateur Division Award and an exhibitor can only win 1 division – Amateur or Select Amateur. An award will be awarded to the High Point (combined score under both judges) in the following halter divisions: Open Stallion, Amateur Stallion, Open Mare, Amateur Mare, Open Gelding, Amateur Gelding, Youth Mares & Youth Geldings. Rosettes for Grand Champion and Reserve Champion and rosettes for first through sixth places will also be offered per judge for each class, except cattle classes. Tie breaker judge to be designated.

**PAYOUT:** Premiums will be paid using the following schedule: One entry pays one place, 100%. Two to five entries pay 2 places, 60%, 40%. Six to nine entries pay 3 places, 50%, 30%, 20%. Ten to thirteen entries pay 4 places, 40%, 30%, 20%, 10%. Fourteen to eighteen entries pay 5 places, 35%, 25%, 20%, 13%, 7%. Nineteen plus entries pay 6 places, 32%, 22%, 19%, 10%, 9%, 8%. Premiums will be paid to cattle classes (1-18) only.

**ONE ENTRY FEE:** One class fee enters exhibitor under two judges. Exhibitor does not have the option of entering only under one Judge unless a conflict exists. There will be one jackpot paid when applicable. Ties for awards and jackpot payback will be announced. All monies will be calculated on the number of entries shown in each class. Paybacks in calf roping and team roping will be based on time. All exhibitors receiving jackpot payback monies must furnish a completed W-9 Form and have paid in full before money is paid out.
