GENERAL RULES: Read the General Rules in the front of the premium list for health requirements, arrival/departure times, stalls, passes, etc.

SCHOLARSHIPS: A \$10,000 and \$6,000 scholarship will be awarded in the Senior (14-18) Youth Division. Points for the scholarships will be computed on a "*one horse, one rider basis*". See General Rules for Scholarship Eligibility and Requirements.

ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE: Horses should not arrive before 8:00 a.m. on Thursday, 2/14/07 and must depart by 10:00 a.m., Sunday, 2/17/08.

ENTRY DEADLINE: Entries must be received by January 31, 2008. "Payment of on-line entries must be received by the Show Secretary within seven (7) days after date of on-line entry."

LATE ENTRIES: Horses entered after the deadline will be charged a late fee of \$10.00 per horse. Late horse entries will be accepted until February 6, 2008.

ADDED CLASSES: A horse already entered in the show may be entered in additional classes until the evening prior to the class.

CLASS FEES: Exhibitors can choose between a **\$135 flat rate fee** (excluding cutting - plus appropriate fees) or **pay for individual classes** which includes the jackpot and cattle fees (see Entry Fees and Class Schedule). Class schedule indicates the total fee for both shows (not including National and Texas Point Fees) if paid by the entry deadline. Entry fees for roping, steer daubing, and cutting classes include cattle charges.

OFFICE FEE: A \$10.00 non-refundable office fee will be charged for each horse entered in the show.

STALLS: A stall is mandatory for every horse entering the grounds. Horse stalls are \$45 and tack stalls are \$55. **All stalls must be purchased in advance with entries. There are no refunds for stall fees.**

PAYBACKS: Checks will be mailed to the owner(s) within ten (10) working days after the show.

REFUNDS: No refund of entries (minus the \$10 per horse office charge) will be made unless a vet certificate is included with the request. There are no refunds for stall fees, parking passes, gate passes or scratched classes.

RETURNED CHECKS: Checks returned prior to the show must be paid in cash or money order prior to or upon arrival at the Show Office. A fee of \$25.00 will be charged for each returned check.

HEALTH CERTIFICATE & COGGINS TEST: All horses entered in the show must have a current Health Certificate and Coggins Test. Health papers must be available to show upon arriving at the gate.

SPECIAL RULES

All shows are approved by the Appaloosa Horse Club, Inc. (ApHC), the Texas Appaloosa Horse Club (TAHC), and the South Texas Appaloosa Breeders (STAB). The Texas Appaloosa Cutting Horse Association has sanctioned the Cutting Classes.

1. The Official Handbook of the Appaloosa Horse Club, Inc. will be followed for the shows.
2. All horses must be registered with the Appaloosa Horse Club, Inc., Moscow, Idaho. At least one horse owner must be an ApHC, Inc. member. A copy of the ApHC registration certificate, both front and back, must accompany the entry. Original copy of the registration certificate must be available during the show.
3. All exhibitors and riders must be current ApHC, Inc. members. Non-Pro contestants must have a Non-Pro Membership card to enter in a Non-Pro class. Novice Non-Pro and Novice Youth Classes will be open to exhibitors as defined in the Official Handbook of the Appaloosa Horse Club, Inc.
4. Show Management reserves the right to cancel or combine any class with insufficient entries.
5. All roping classes, timed and judged, game classes, and cutting classes will have only one (1) run.
6. Points for high point awards will be accumulated over both shows. In the event of a tie in any of the High Point Categories, the winner will be determined by the most first, second, third places, etc. Judge A is designated as the tiebreaker for special awards.
7. Halter and showmanship classes (open, non-pro and youth) will count towards the high-point awards.
8. Points for the following awards will be computed on a "*one horse, one rider basis*":
 - * **Hi Point Non-Pro** (Buckle)
 - * **Hi Point Non-Pro, 35 & Over** (Buckle)
 - * **Hi Point Non-Pro Novice** (Buckle)

 - * **Hi Point Youth, 14-18** (Saddle)
 - * **Hi Point Youth, 13 & Under** (Saddle)
 - * **Hi Point Novice Youth, 18 & Under** (Buckle)
 - * **Hi Point W/T Youth, 10 & Under** (Buckle)
